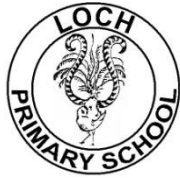

Bicycles For Humanity is a volunteer run, grass roots charity organisation focused on the alleviation of poverty through sustainable transport – in the form of a bike. Every year around 1.5 million bikes are sold across Australia – it is estimated that around half of these will end up unused or abandoned. We put this huge resource to work in some of the poorest countries in the world.

In collaboration with the rotary club of Korumburra, Loch and Korumburra primary schools are clearing out our disused bicycles from our Bikes program and they are being donated to "Bicycles for humanity." For every bike that we are able to contribute to this wonderful program that assists people in poor & remote places around the developing world, The Korumburra Rotary club will pay the required \$20:00 that must accompany each bike which helps to pay for any repairs and transport costs.

Would you like to donate any older bikes that you have that may be just lying around unused? If you do then great! Just bring them to school and we'll take care of the rest.
